Situate in district No 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Wilhem Willink and others No 2778; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam No 2779; dated the 13th. Day of December 1792.
