



Situate on the Waters of Flaugherty's Creek and Waters of Scaffold Camp Run a branch of Wills Creek, including part of the Road from Berlin to Fort Cumberland, part none in Southampton Township, late Londonderry Township, and part in Elk Lick Township, late Bedford County now Somerset County and surveyed the 13th Day of May 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 29th Day of March 1794 by Alexander M^cClear Esquire Late Deputy Surveyor.
