



Situate in Pinegrove township Schuylkill county containing fifty five acres and sixty perches and the allowance of six per cent. being part of a larger tract of two hundred and eighteen acres and a quarter, originally surveyed on the 8th day of September 1815 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 26th day of April 1815 granted Jacob Zimmerman. Returned this 28th day of February 1829 as the property of John Buechler at his request.
