



Draught of a tract of land from documents in my office appears to have been surveyed the 24th day of June 1788 by Benjamin Lodge then D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Woods bearing date June 7th 1788. situated in South Huntingdon Township Westmoreland County, said to contain One hundred and Eighty nine acres and allowance. But by an examination of the lines on the ground, found to contain One hundred and Thirty three acres and allowance of Six p Cent. Surveyed by request of Samuel Mitchel. Nov. 3rd 1817 Thomas Potter D.S.

From examination found that John Robison has obtained Fifty Six acres by prior right which is specified in the above plot of dotted Lines
