In pursuance of a Warrant for 146 acres of land dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of January 1813, was surveyed on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April 1813 for John Wintworth the above described tract of Land containing 202<sup>as</sup> 150<sup>ps</sup> and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. situate on the East side of and adjoining French Creek in Wayne Township Crawford County Pa. and at the time of making said survey the said John Wintworth was actually living on the same with his family and had a house, barn &c. and had upwards of 30 acres of the land cleared fenced and in a good state of cultivation.
