



A Draft of a tract of two hundred & three acres and seventy perches of land & the allowance of 6^{pr} Ct for roads &c. Situate in Northampton township Bucks County (it being part of a tract which was originally surveyed to George Willard on a Warrant for Four hundred acres dated the 24th of 7th m^o 1684 but no return having been made of the Survey thereof into the Office of the Surveyor General. it has been resurveyed and contains Four hundred & Thirty two acres and Eighty seven perches and the allowance of 6^{pr} Ct) the above has by a regular chain of Title from the said George Willard become vested in James Edams & Gayer Edams as Tenants in Common in fee and was for them resurveyed January 22nd 1821 per.
