Survey'd on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February 1810 unto Michael Shade in right of Adam Weaver by Virtue of a Warrant dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 1759 per John M Hyneman Esq<sup>r</sup> late deputy Surveyor.
