



By Order of the Proprietary survey'd the 11th day of March 1735/6 to Reynard Young a Tract of Land in Hempfield Township in Lancaster County. Beginning at a Hicory a Corner of Henry Wellers Land thence East south East 306 p. to a Black Oak thence North North East 156 1/2 p to a Stake thence West 109 1/2 to a Black Oak thence South 14 p to a Spanish Oak thence West North West 168 p to a Maple thence South West 110 p to the place of Beginning - Containing 191 acres & the usual allowance for roads &c.
