



A Draught of a Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Reading in the County of Berks. Containing in Breadth North and South on Lord Street sixty feet and in Length East and West on Hamilton Street 230 feet. Bounded Southward with Hamilton Street. Westward with a Twenty feet Alley. Northward with Lot. No 358 and Eastward with Lord Street. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 9th day of February 1769 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Youngman dated the same day
