



A Draught of a Tract of land situate in Allen formerly Pennsboro Township Cumberland County, containing Seven acres Seventy seven perches & the usual allowance for roads &c. It being part of a larger tract of land containing 245<sup>as</sup> 143 perches & allowance of six per Cent. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Whiteside for 100<sup>as</sup> of land bearing date the 24<sup>th</sup> day of April A. Domini 1750. The Survey of the above described seven acres and Seventy seven perches was made on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May A. Domini 1810 by William Wheeler then Deputy Surveyor
