



A draught of a survey lying on Campbells Run a branch of Char-tiers Creek, in Washington County, Contg 382 Ac^s & 152Ps without any allow^{cs} executed Feby 7th 1786 in pursuance of a certificate in these words.

"We the Commissioners appointed to adjust the claims to unpatented Lands in y^e Counties of Monongalia, Johg^a and Ohio do hereby certify that Jn^o Wolf is entitled to Four hundred Ac^s of land in y^e County of Yohiogany on the Waters of Shirtier Ck to include his Settlement 1773 also a right in Preemption to one thousand ac^s adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Cox's Fort y^e 23^d Feby 1780 in y^e 4th year of y^e Commonwealth.
