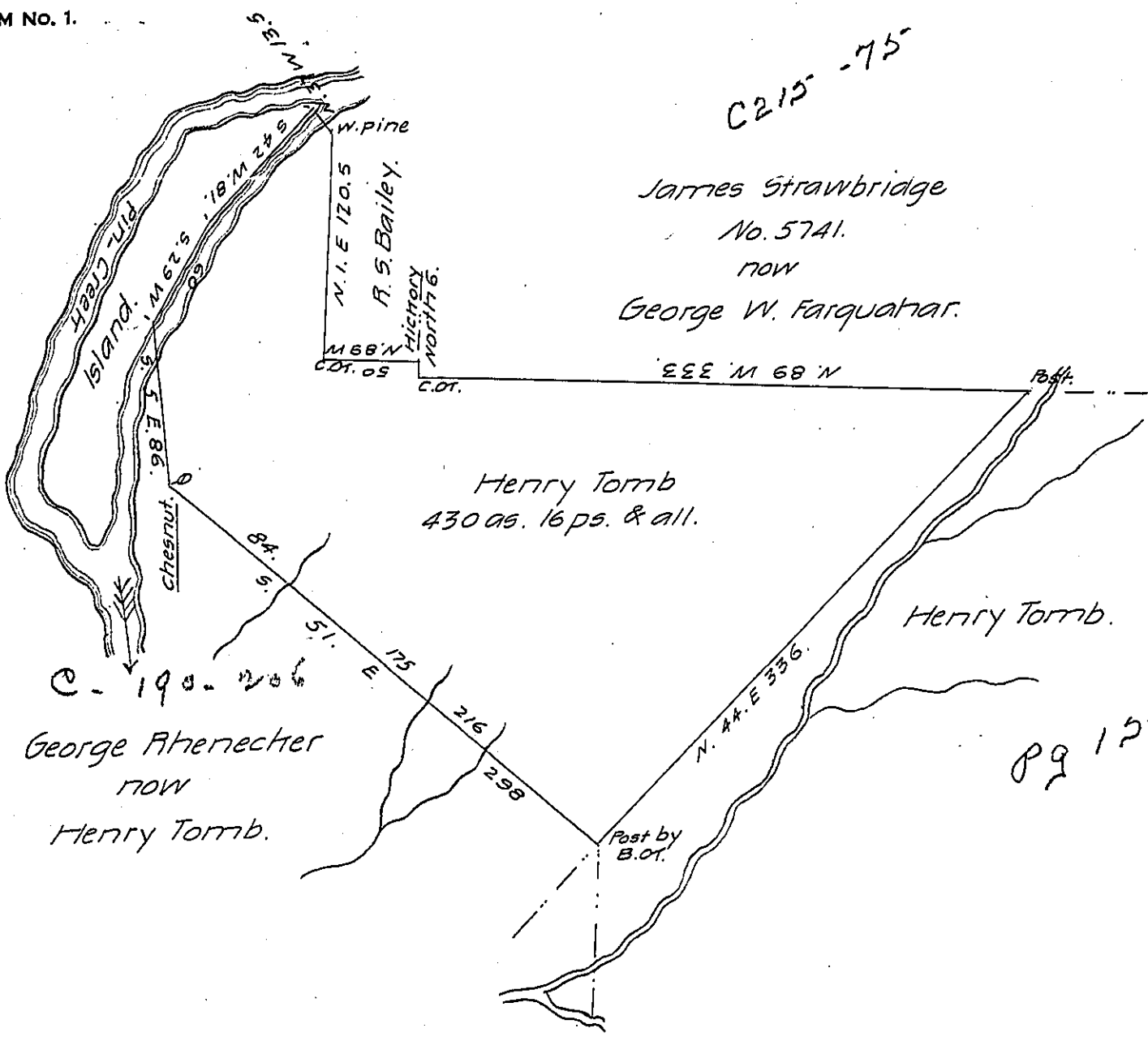


FORM No. 1.



Surveyed the above described tract of land the thirtieth day of January A.D. 1839, for Henry Tomb by virtue of his warrant for 400 acres dated October 23rd 1838. Containing four hundred & thirty acres & sixteen perches & allowance of six per cent &c. Situate on the East Side of Pine Creek, and in Cummings township, Lycoming County & bounded as above described.

Note. the improvements are about 101 acres cleared land, & a house on it began in 1797.
