 to Arthur Rodgers on the 2d day of June A.D. 1817, by virtue of a war-  
 rant granted to Jacob Wolfgang dated the 11th of January A.D. 1814  
 (the survey was made on the date above mentioned as appears  
 by a draught deposited in the Deputy Surveyors office of Schuyl-  
 kill County. Returned to James McFarland Esq. then D. Surveyor.)
