



A Draught of part of a tract of land surveyed by John Henderson Esquire late Deputy Surveyor for John Whitehead on his warrant dated July 1st 1784 and in pursuance of an order from the Board of Property dated the 21st of January 1822 granted to John Young there was surveyed on the 1st day of August 1822 the above described piece of land containing one hundred and three acres and 114 P with an allowance of six P. Cent situate in Unity Township in the County of Westmoreland P.
