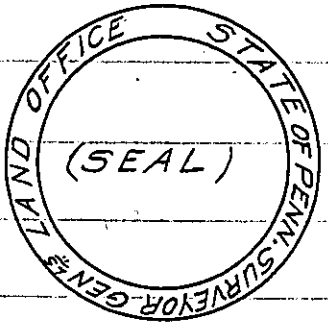


A draught of a Tract of land Situate in Mohontango Towhship in the County of Northumberland
