



Situate in Frankstown Township in the County of Huntingdon Resurveyed the 17th day of August 1805 In pursuance of an order No 19 dated the 1st day of August 1766 containing Three hundred and Twenty five acres Eleven Perches and the usual allowance for Roads.

Note: it appears by an old Draft in my possession that a survey was made taking in the above land on Edward Wood's order on the 2^d day of December 1766, Michael Simpson claims the Triangle A in virtue of a survey made for Archabald McElroy, and John Werham claims all the Tract in virtue of a survey made for him on the 24th October 1803 In pursuance of his Warrant dated the 5th day of September 1803.
