



The above is a Draught of a survey made May the 21st day 1794, In pursuance of a warrant granted to George Wallis Esq. for 400 acres of land dated February the 10th. 1794 situate north and west of the River Ohio adjoining John Mc Dowell to the Eastward and to the South of the large stream which empties into Big Beaver Creek on the waters of pine Creek in District No 9. called Hunters Camp Containing four hundred thirty nine acres and thirty four poles together with the usual allowance of six Per Cent for Roads.
