



A Draught of a tract of Land situate on the south side of Alligany River on a small Run emptying in to the said River in Westmoreland County containing Three Hundred and thirty five Acres and the usual allowance of six Pct for Roads &c. Surveyed the 13th of October 1775 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Robt Turner out of the Proprietary Land office bearing date February 28. 1774.
