



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 on a certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Nine, Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of the Square Sixty feet, and in Length North and South One hundred and Seventy feet, Bounded Northward by the aforesaid Square, Eastward by Lot Number Twelve, Southward by Barberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Eight. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 6<sup>th</sup> day of February 1775 for Robert Wilson by Wt dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of December 1774.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made comformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of May 1907.
