



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Ninety five. Containing in Breadth North and South Sixty feet and in Length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Westward by Fourth Street Northward by Lot Number one hundred and Ninety four Eastward by Mission Alley and Southward by Lot Number One hundred and Ninety Six. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 13th day of April 1775 for Jonas Weaver.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February 1832, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of May 1907.
