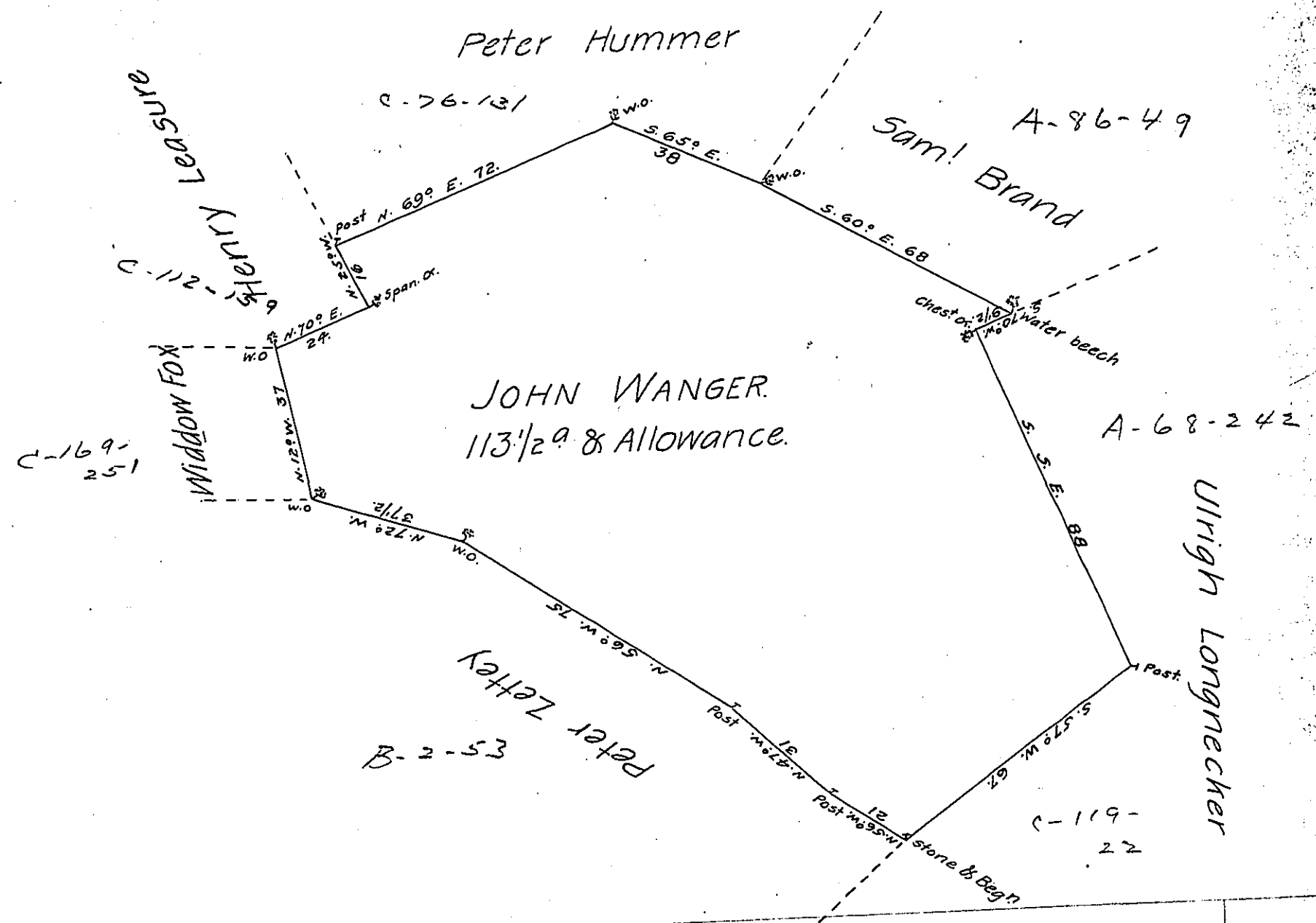

See the Warr^t in Letter **W**, Lancas^r County, N^o 379 by the name of Wenger.

To John Lukens, Surv^r. Gen^l!

Sir:- the bearer John Wanger enforms me that he has been at your office to take a patent for the above Land, & could not find his D^t which is certainly Return'd by your Receipt, as the Man Neglected to bring the Receipt for the money p^d to the Office, - can not return you the the date of the Warrant as it was Survey'd on it.
