



Situate in Fawn Township now Peach Bottom in the County of York Containing as above set forth 45 ²/₃ & 114 perches and allowance being part of a larger Tract of 178 ²/₃ & 21 perches and allowance which was originally surveyed to the heirs of Robert Taylor in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Hugh Whiteford and John Taylor executors of the said Robert Taylor dated September 24th A.D. 1765, Resurveyed and divided off from said larger Tract on the 15th day of April A.D. 1809, and now on the 22nd Day of June A.D. 1838 the same is resurveyed, Calculated, Corrected and returned at the instance and request of Andrew Anderson the present owner who wishes to patent it.
