Surveyed on the 1st day of March 1777 by Charles Lukens the then Deputy Surveyor of the district, for Isaac Gray by virtue of his order of Survey bearing date the third day of April 1769 & N^o. 2551 which will appear by the Original drafts remaining in my office at Sunbury. & Surveyed by me on the 20th day of November 1792 by virtue of the above Recited order agreeable to the old lines, Containing three hundred & Sixteen Acres & three quarters & the usual allow^{es}. &c
