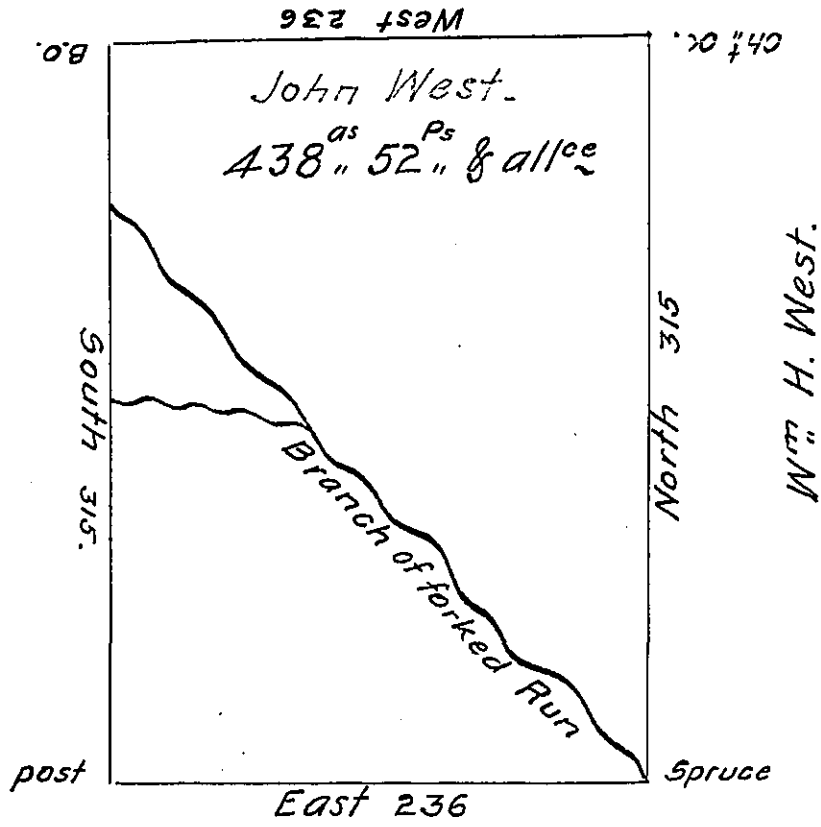


Francis West
