



A draft of a tract of land situate in the Head of the Great Cove on a Branch of Licking Creek in Air Township Bedford County containing One hundred & thirty seven Acres & Sixty four Perches & Allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for John & Hugh McClellan on Order No. 589 dated the 1st day of August 1766.

No. 1. represented by the broken lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Joseph Woods in pursuance of a Warrant date - the 16th day of August 1785. This tract interferes seven Acres & one hundred & sixty four perches with the John & Hugh McClellan Tract - Joseph Woods conveyed to Christopher Nead who conveyed to Christian Waggoner the present owner - John & Hugh McClellan conveyed to Matthias Ambrose who conveyed the Interference to Thomas Paxton who conveyed to Adam Rues who conveyed Christian Waggoner who also claimed under the Joseph Woods and is the present owner
