



By Virtue of a Certificate granted to Robert Walker for four hundred acres of land by the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohagania & Ohio, duly entered with Robert Woods Esq. Deputy Surveyor of Ohio County as appears by a Certified Copy signed by John Hoge Esq. Late Deputy Surveyor the above described tract of land containing four hundred and nineteen acres Strict Measure Situate on the waters of Buffaloe in Washington County was ^{re} surveyed on the 18th day of October 1796 by John Hoge Esquire Late Deputy Surveyor and now examined and certified to be correct this 14th day of January 1805
