The above land is claimed by Michael Strubhar Jun<sup>r</sup> by virtue of a warrant granted to him dated December 3<sup>d</sup> 1829. It would appear to me from the description of Michael Strubhar Jun<sup>r</sup>'s warrant that it was not intended at the time it issued to be located on the above land but upon other land about 2 miles distant therefrom.
