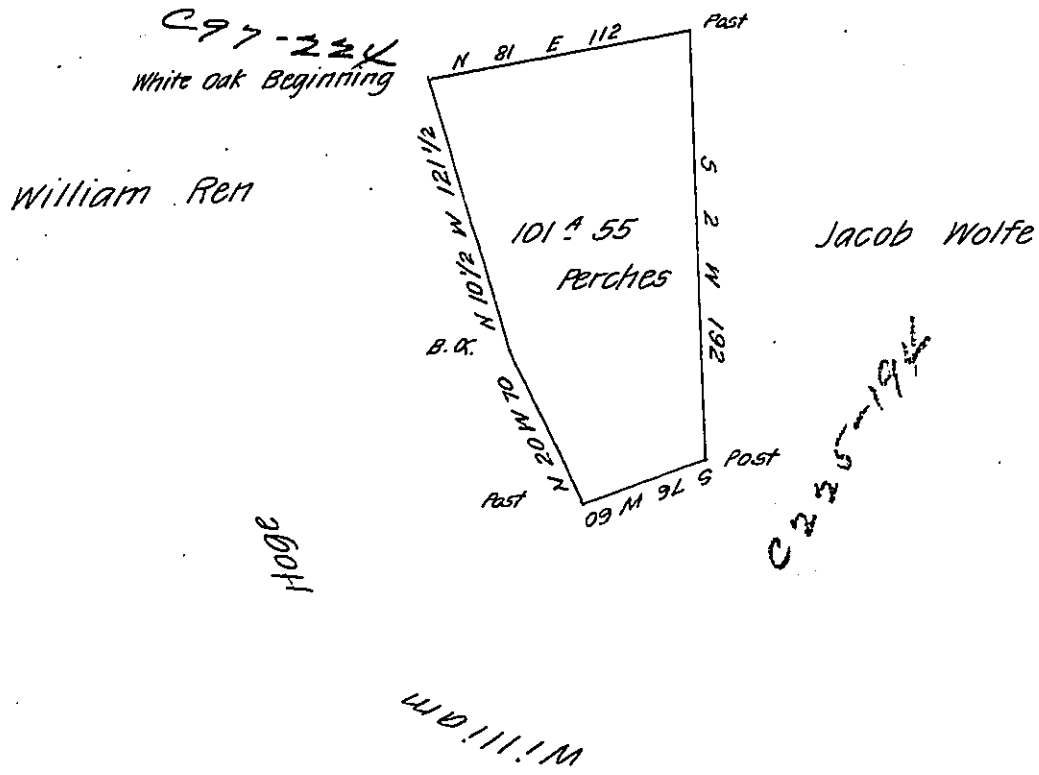

By Virtue of a Warrant granted to Jacob Wolfe dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of July 1794 the above described tract of land containing one hundred one acres & fifty five perches together with six Per Cent allowance for Roads Situate on the waters of Buffaloe in Donegal Township Washington County was Surveyed on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of September 1794 by Thomas Stokely Esquire late Deputy Surveyor and now examined and Certified to be correct this 4<sup>th</sup> day of February 1804
