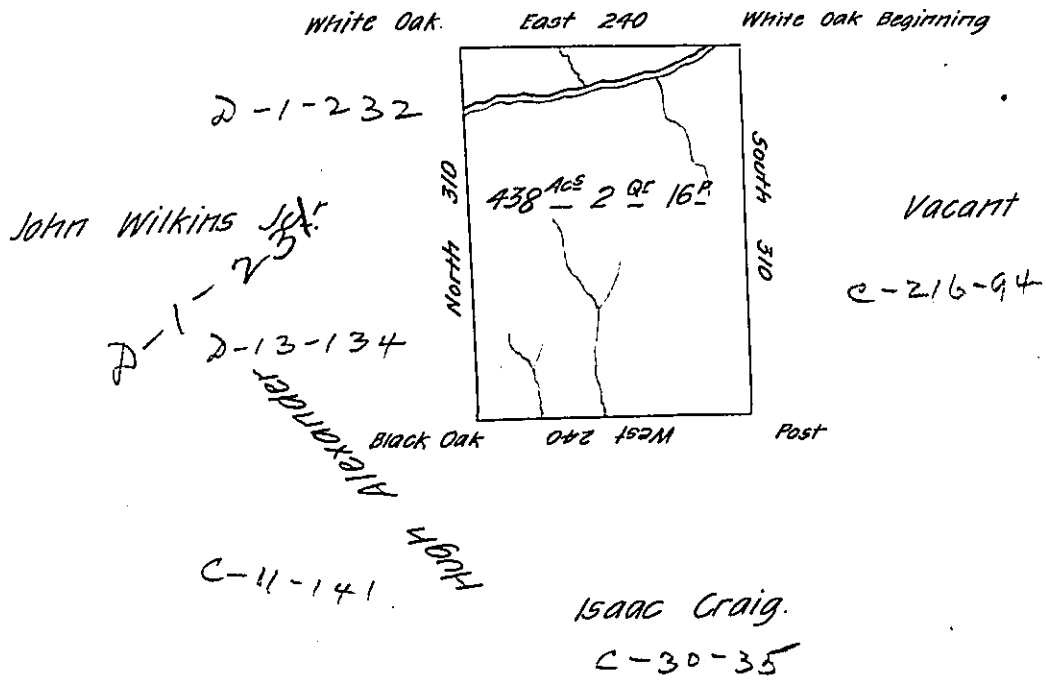

The above is a draught of a Survey made April the 4th 1794 in pursu-
 ance of a warrant granted to John Wilkins for 400 Acres of Land dated the tenth
 day of February 1794 adjoining Hugh Alexander on the East Side of the Venango
 Path including the head waters of a stream which empties into the Alleghany-
 on the Waters of Pine Creek North and West of the River Ohio Called Mount pleas-
 ant Containing four hundred thirty eight and an half acres and sixteen poles
 together with the usual allowance of six P^{er} Cent
