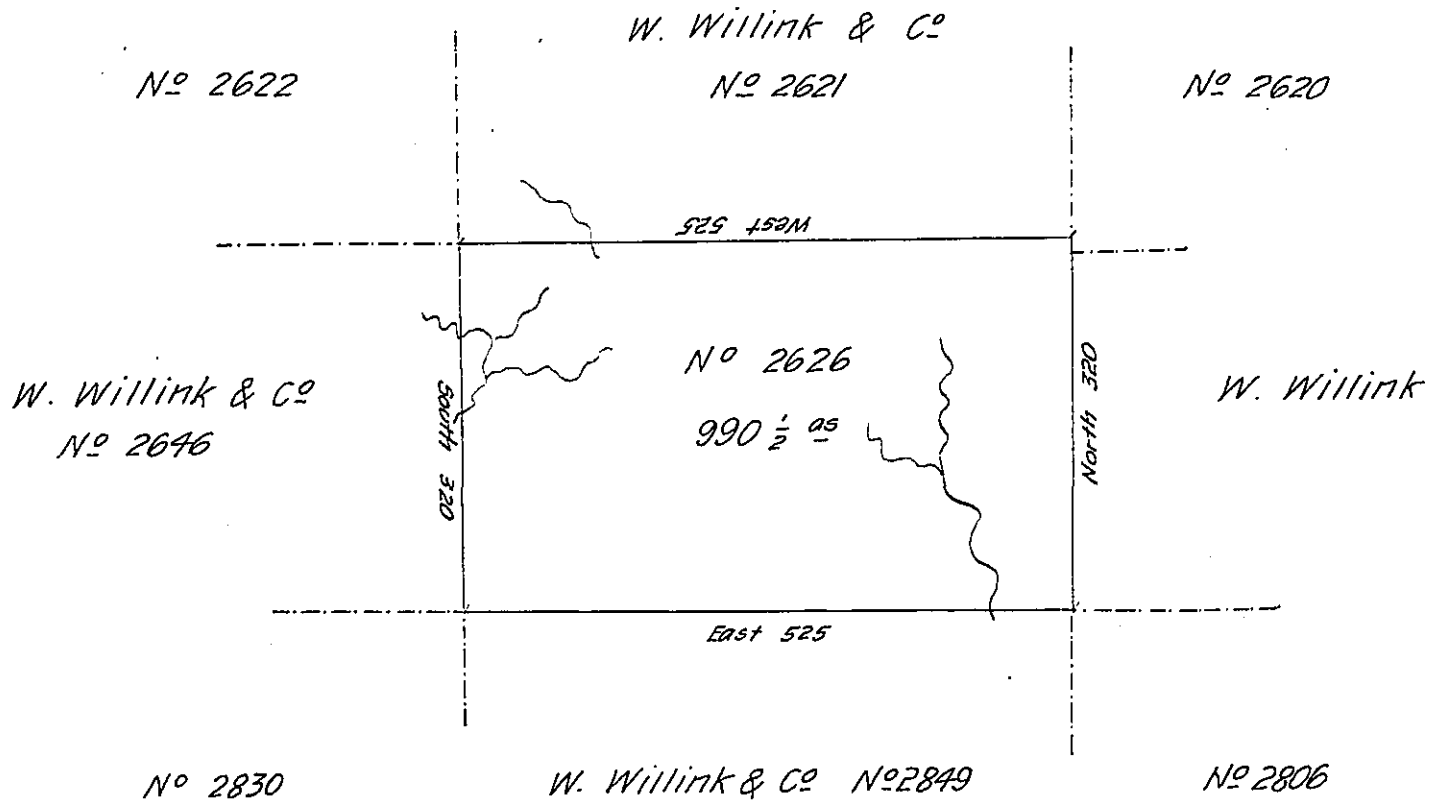

By virtue of a warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> December 1792 No 2626 there was surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> August 1794 by W<sup>m</sup> P. Brady the former Deputy Surveyor to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of Nine hundred & Ninety 1/2 acres & Allowance situate on the waters of Sandy Lick Creek in the late Purchase District No 5 in the County of Lycoming A Copy of which remains in my office
