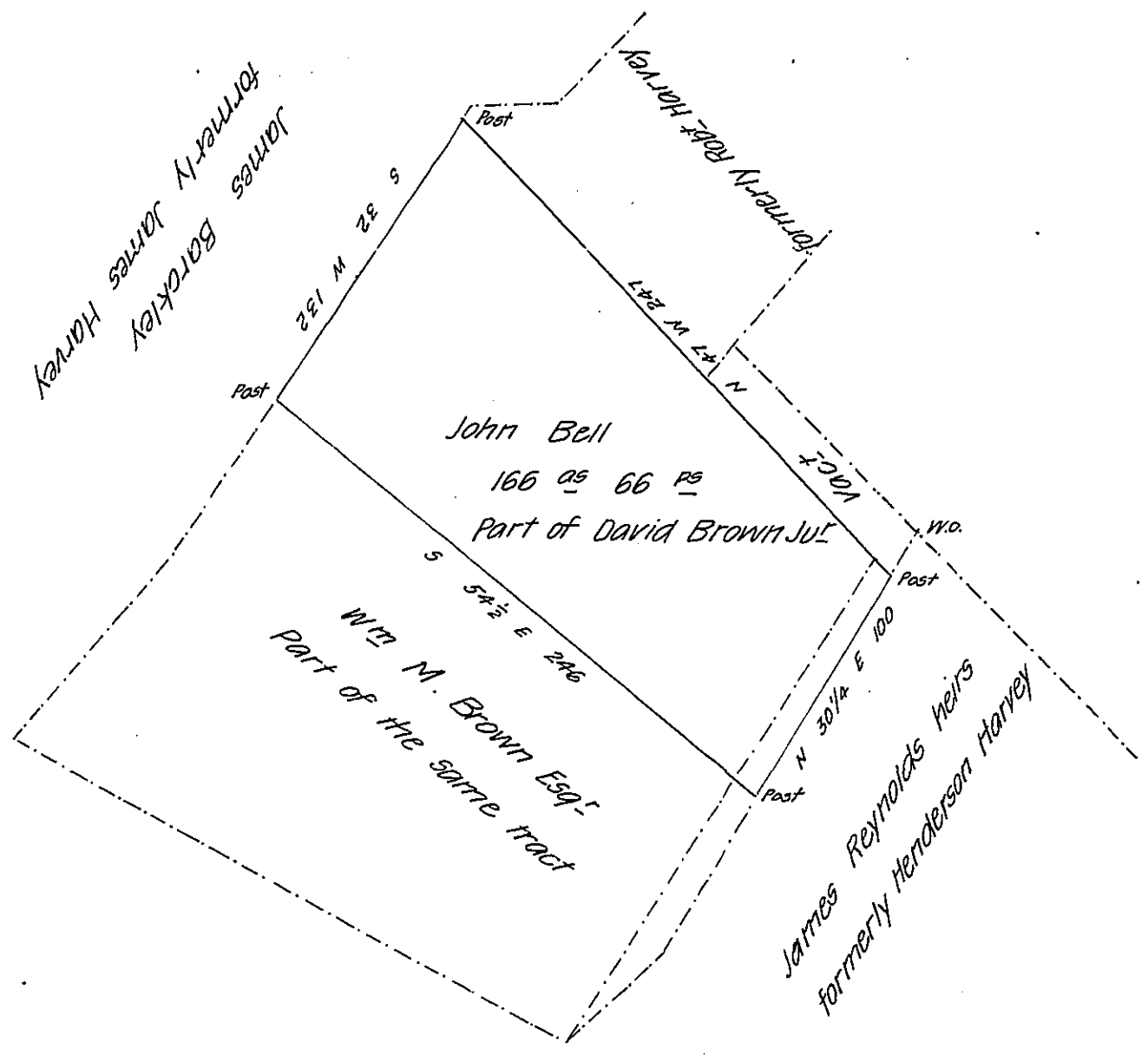


FORM NO 1.



The above described Tract of one hundred and Sixty Six Acres and Sixty Six perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c is part of a larger tract of 311 Acres 146 Perches & allowance situate in Metal Township Franklin County (formerly Fannet Township Cumberland County) which was Surveyed the first day of May 1769 in pursuance of an Order of Survey Granted to David Brown Junior dated the 2nd of July 1767 N^o 4103. Resurveyed and laid off for John Bell the 6th of May 1822

Note It appears that the line laid down on the Original of the above Survey would not join the line of Henderson Harvey's old Survey - having ran ^{inside} the line on the Ground - no marks has been found - Block^d some trees on the out side line, no marks discovered older than 21 or 22 years - Mr Bell insisted to extend the outside line which I have done at his request no other claim appearing for the land
