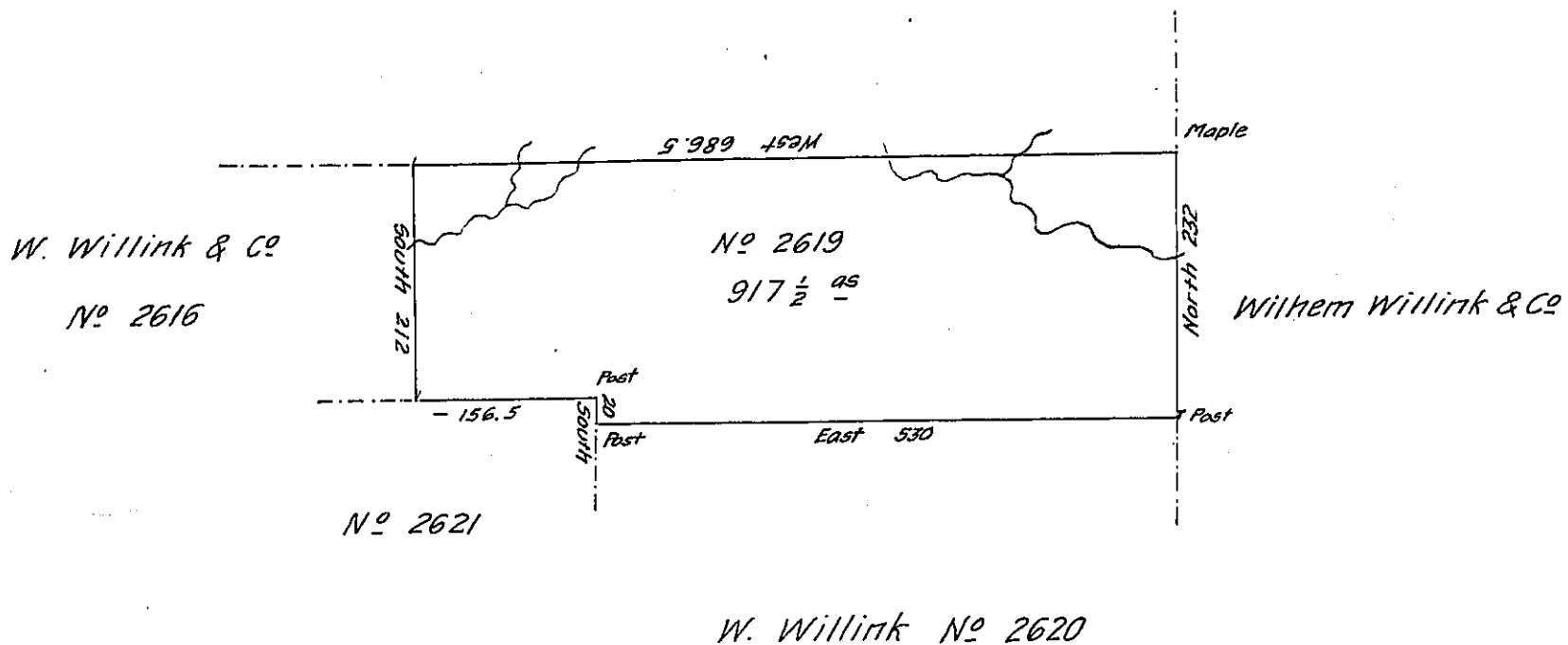


Jeremiah Parker

Brady the former Deputy Surveyor.) to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of nine hundred & Seventeen acres & one half & allowance situate on the waters of Sandy Lick Creek in District No 5 in the late purchase in the County of Lycoming.
