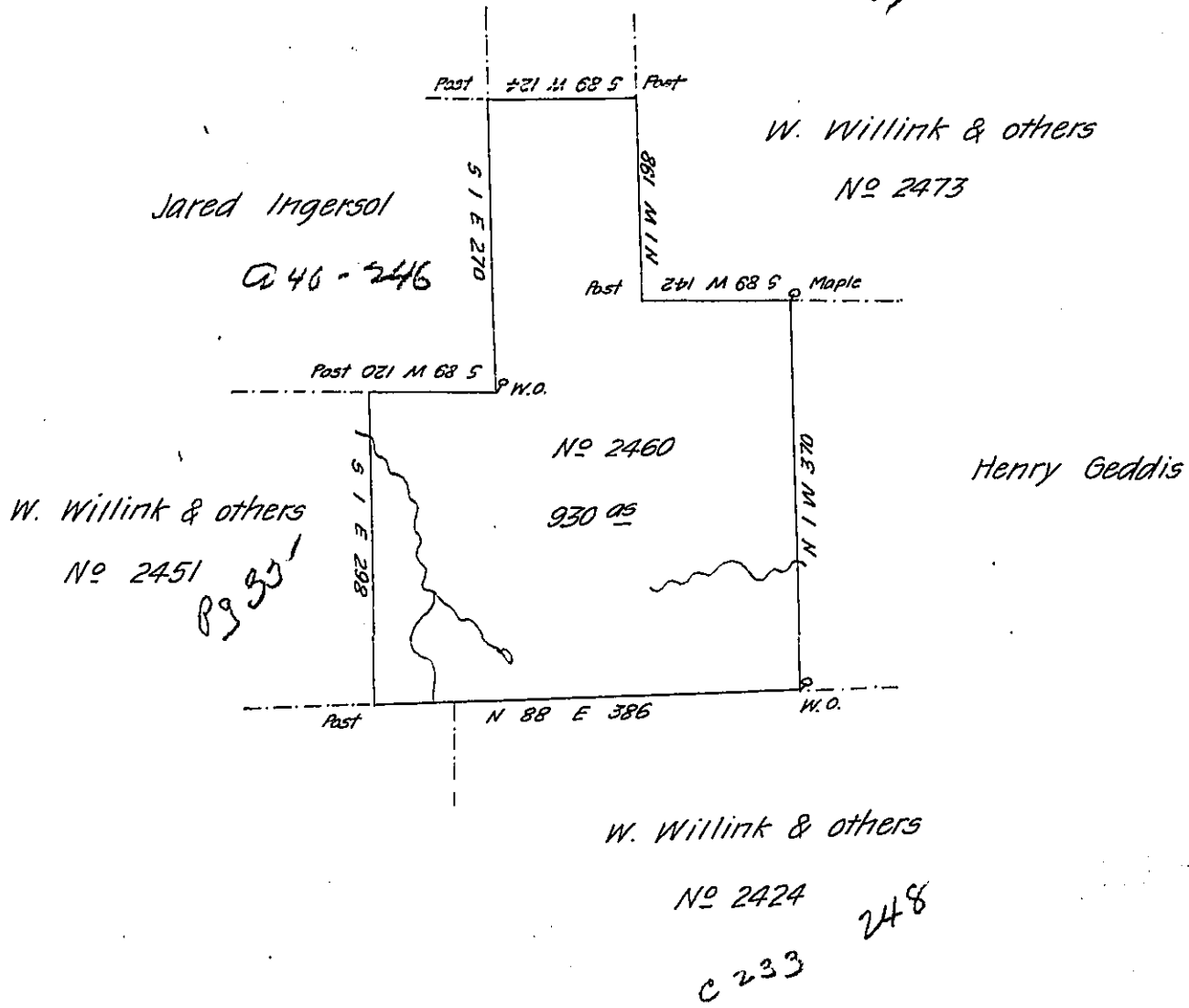

Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor) to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of land of nine hundred & thirty acres & allowance situate on the waters of Stump Creek in District No 5 in the late purchase in the County of Lycoming - a Copy of which remains in my Office
