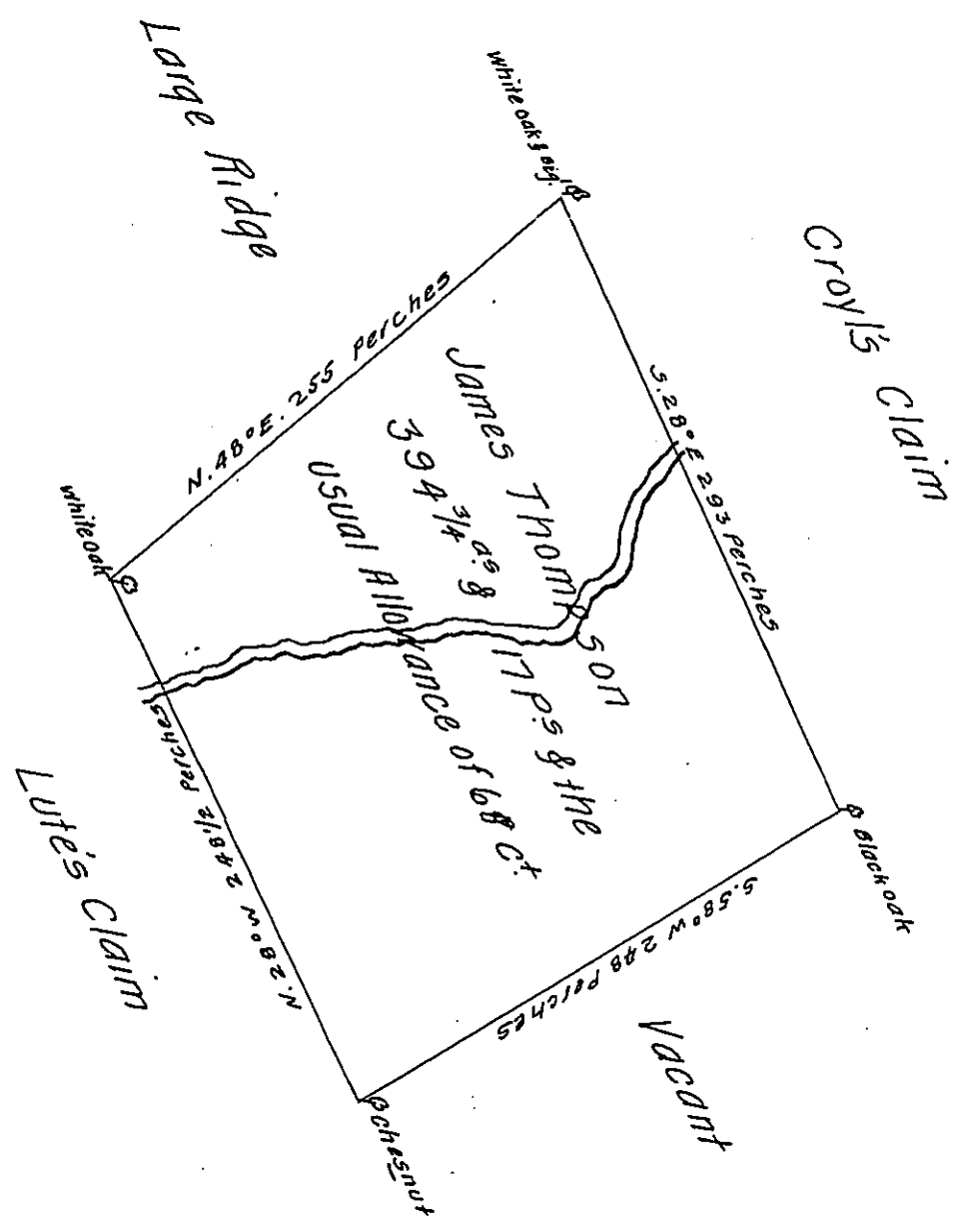


FORM NO 1.



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on a large Run a few Miles eastward of Dunnings Creek. Including James Thompson's Improvement. Containing three Hundred Ninety four Acres and three fourths of an Acre & Seventeen Perches and the Usual Allowance of Six Acres & Cent for Roads and Highways, Surveyed the first Day of August 1766 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted James Thompson the 9th day of June 1762.
