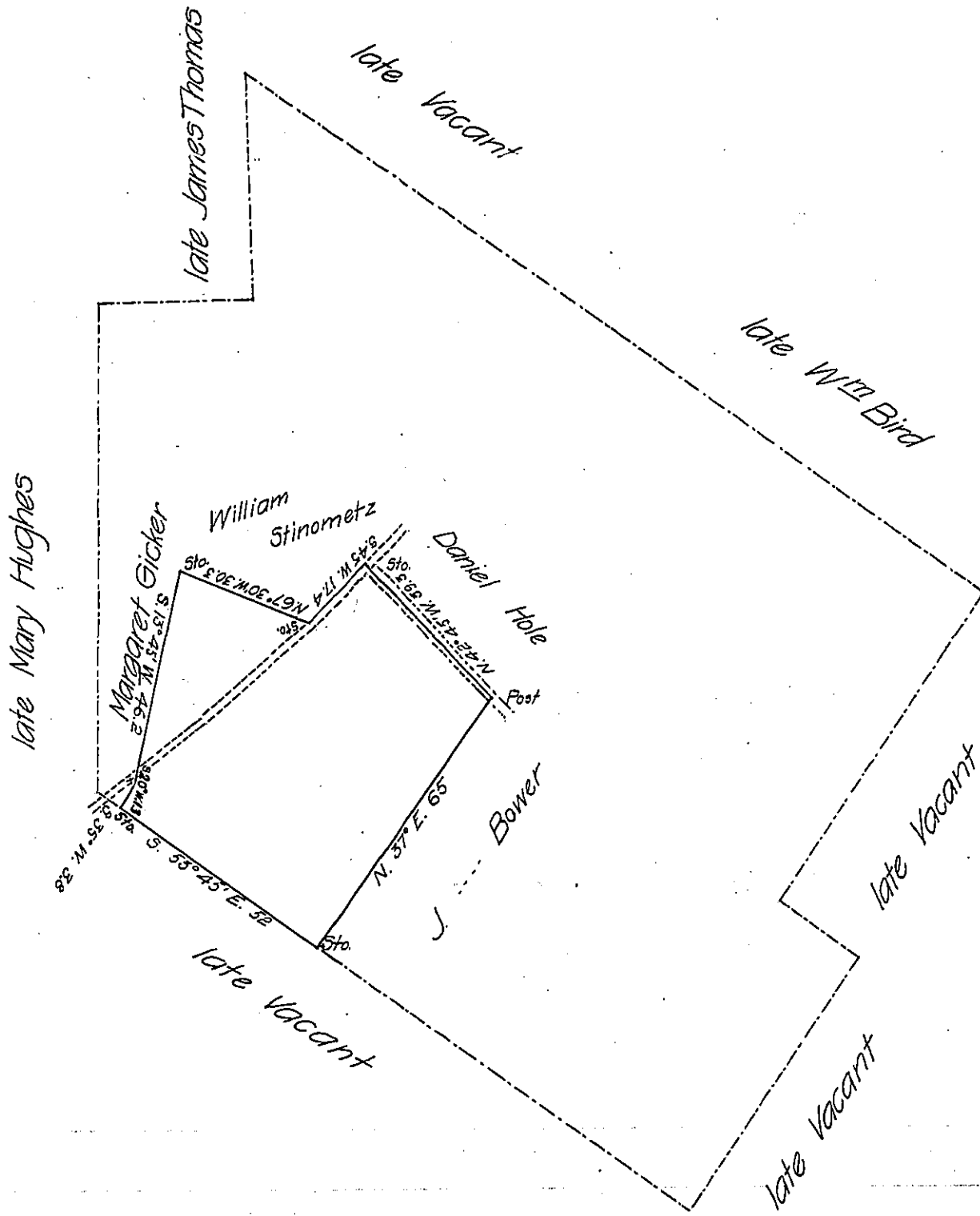

Draft of a tract of land situate in Robeson Township, in the county of Berks, containing Twenty two acres, One hundred and five perches, and allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c, surveyed for Peter Livingood, Jacob DeTurk & Frederick Deturk the Nineteenth day of April 1870, being part of a larger tract of One hundred and fifty five acres ——— perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Benjamin Williams dated the First day of May 1751.
