



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> May, 1785, Surveyed the 24<sup>th</sup> November, 1785, to James Wells the above described tract of Land situate about half a mile North of Shohola creek, about two miles from the confluence of said creek with the River Delaware on a small path leading from Shohola house to Hansom Eddy in the County of Northampton containing One hundred and twenty two Acres thirty seven perches and the allowance of six ~~7~~ Cent & c<sup>a</sup>.
