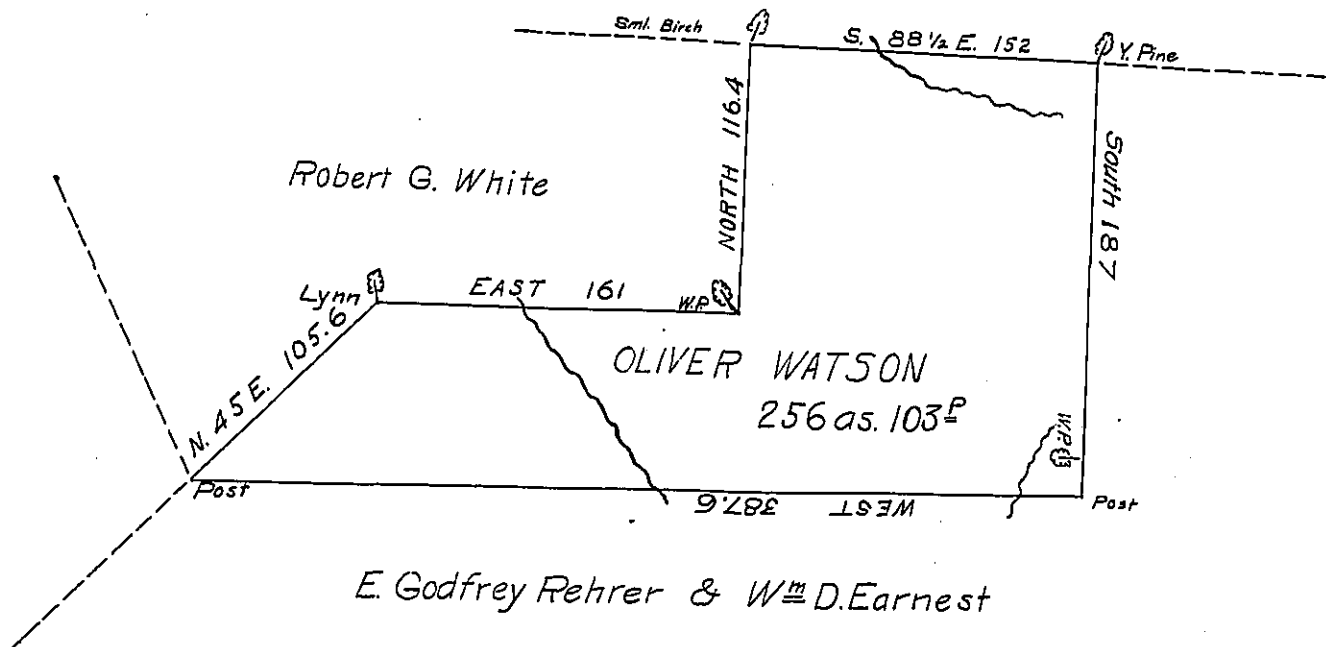


John Barron, No. 5527.
