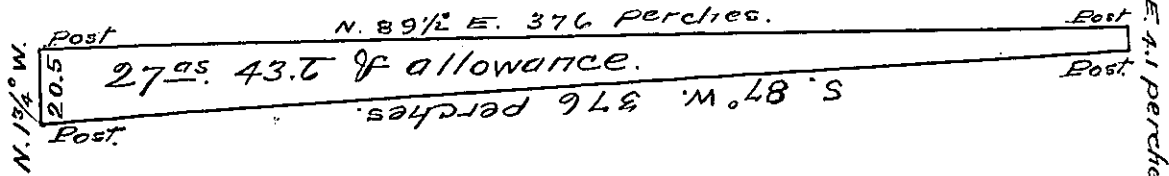

Wallace of the City of Pittsburgh Pa. dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of August A. D. 1856 Containing twenty seven acres and forty three and six tenths perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c fenced and clearing commenced, which from the books and documents in my possession does not appear to have been Surveyed or appropriated to any other person. Surveyed Surveyed Sept. 13<sup>th</sup>. 1856 bounded as above described.
