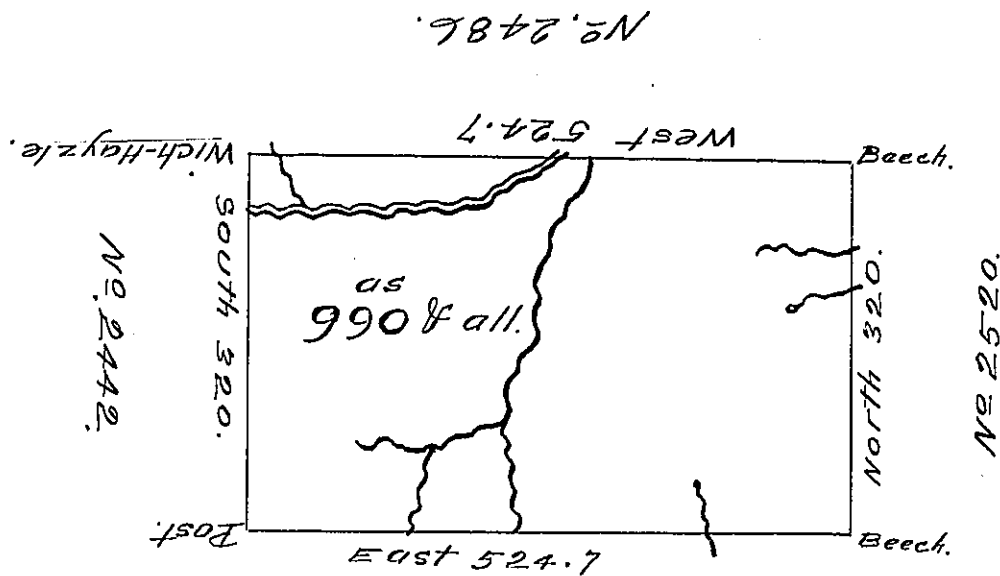

SITUATE about two Miles South of the Middle Branch of Sinamahoning Creek above the Driftwood and about eight miles West of the Driftwood-in-North d. County Containing 990 Acres and the usual allowance for Roads &c. Surveyed September 4th 1793 for Wilhem Willink Nicholaas Van Stopherst Christaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schemmelpennich in pursuance of a Warrant No. 2507, bearing date December 12th 1792.
