



Situated on Dunning's Creek formerly in Cumberland, now Bedford County Containing 470 Acres 39 perches with the allowance of six P^t Cent for Roads &c. (being one of the Tracts within the boundaries of a large survey made for George Croghan May 22^d. 1766 by Robert McKensie under Richard Tea D.S.) Resurveyed August 30th. 1797 on Warrant granted to Lewis Price Dated June 1st. 1763

N.B. A Survey in the name of James George Woods D.S. Williams made July 27th 1786 on Warrant dated August 22^d 1785.
