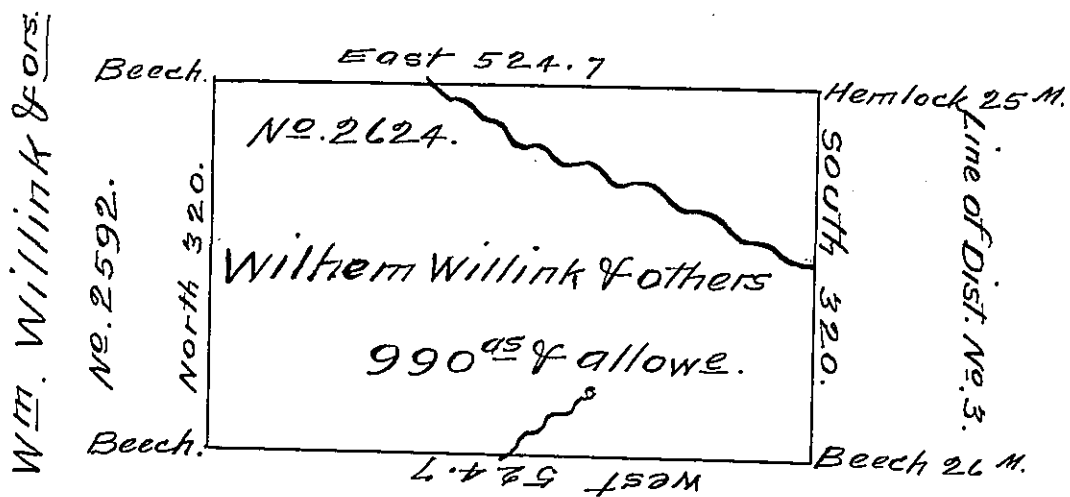

Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety 9<sup>as</sup> & the usual allowance of six per cent. for Roads &c.
