



In pursuance of a Warrant for 33 acres dated the 24 day of June A. D. 1816 was surveyed the 11th day of July 1816 for Hugh Williamson the above described tract of Land containing twenty six Acres one hundred forty six perches and allowance of six per. Cent for Roads &c. and at the time of making said Survey the said Hugh Williamson was living on the same with his family and he had a convenient house and there appeared upwards of ten acres of the Land cleared and fenced situate in Mead Township Crawford County Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
