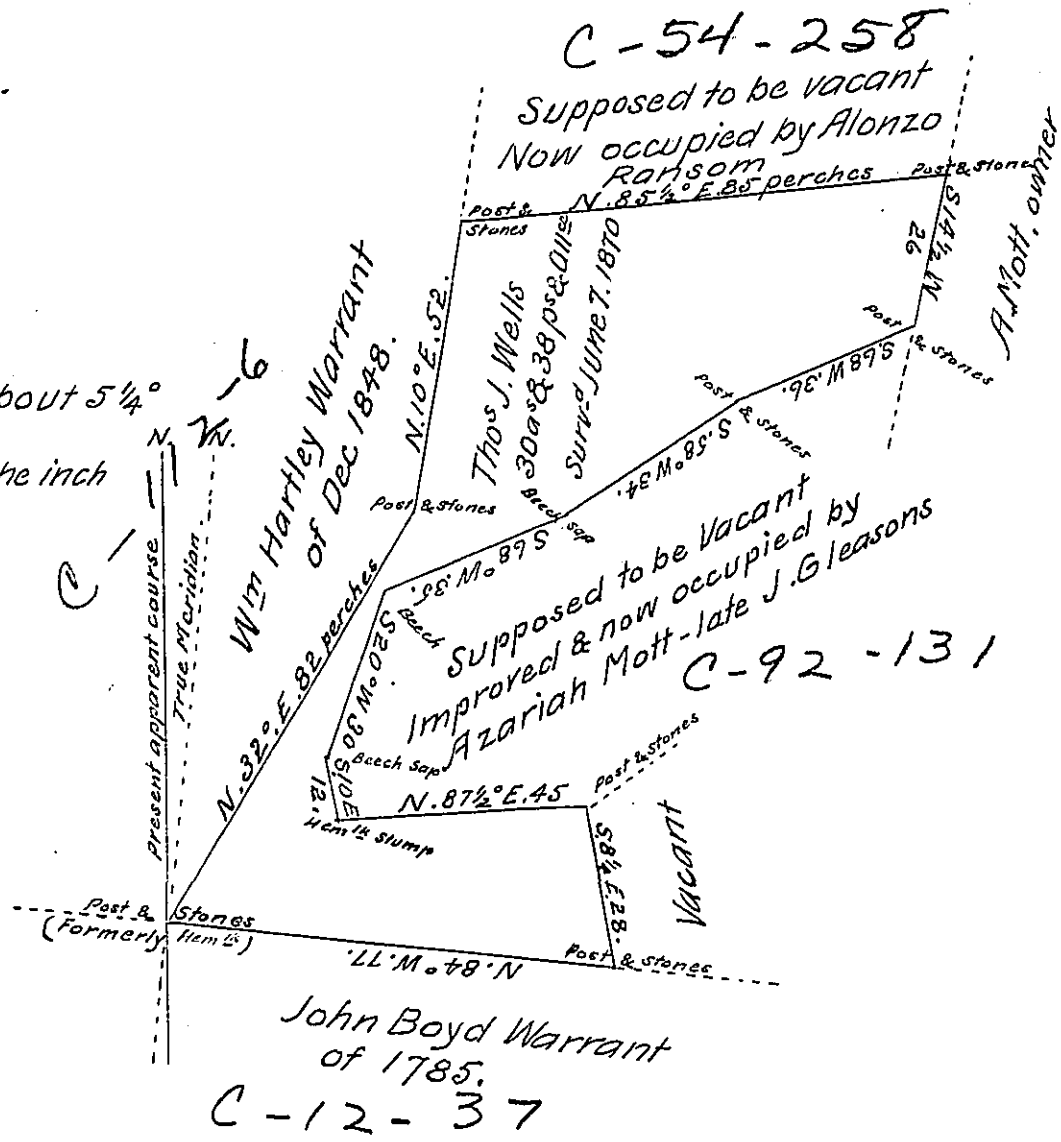

Draft of a tract of unimproved land situate in Lenox township Susque Co
 Beginning at a post & stones (formerly Hemlock) corner of a tract in the
 Warrantee name of William Hartley, in the North line of "John Boyd" (warrantee)
 Thence by said Hartley tract N. 32° E. Eighty two perches to a post & stones &
 North 10° East fifty two perches to post & stones corner of land now occupied by
 Alonzo Ransom, Thence by said land (supposed to be vacant) South 85 1/2° East
 eighty five perches to a post & stones in line of land occupied by Azariah Mott
 Thence by improved land of said Mott (still supposed to be vacant) South 14 1/2°
 West twenty six perches - South Sixty eight degrees West thirty six perches to
 post & stones - South fifty eight degrees West thirty four perches to a Beech
 Sapling: South sixty eight degrees West thirty five perches to a Beech, South twenty degrees
 West thirty perches to a Beech sapling - South ten degrees East twelve perches to a
 Hemlock Stump, and north eighty seven & a half degrees East forty five perches to a
 post & stones: thence South eight & a quarter degrees East twenty eight perches by vacant
 land unimproved to a post in the aforesaid line of the John Boyd Warrant: and thence
 by the same North Eighty four degrees West seventy seven perches to the place of beginning - Containing

thirty acres & thirty Eight perches & allowance of six percent, Surveyed June 7th 1870. in pursuance
 of a Warrant granted to T. J. Wells for twenty four acres & c, dated the 16th day of May A.D. 1870.
 To J. M. Campbell Esq Sur Gen. Montrose May 20. 1870. James W. Chapman Cs.
