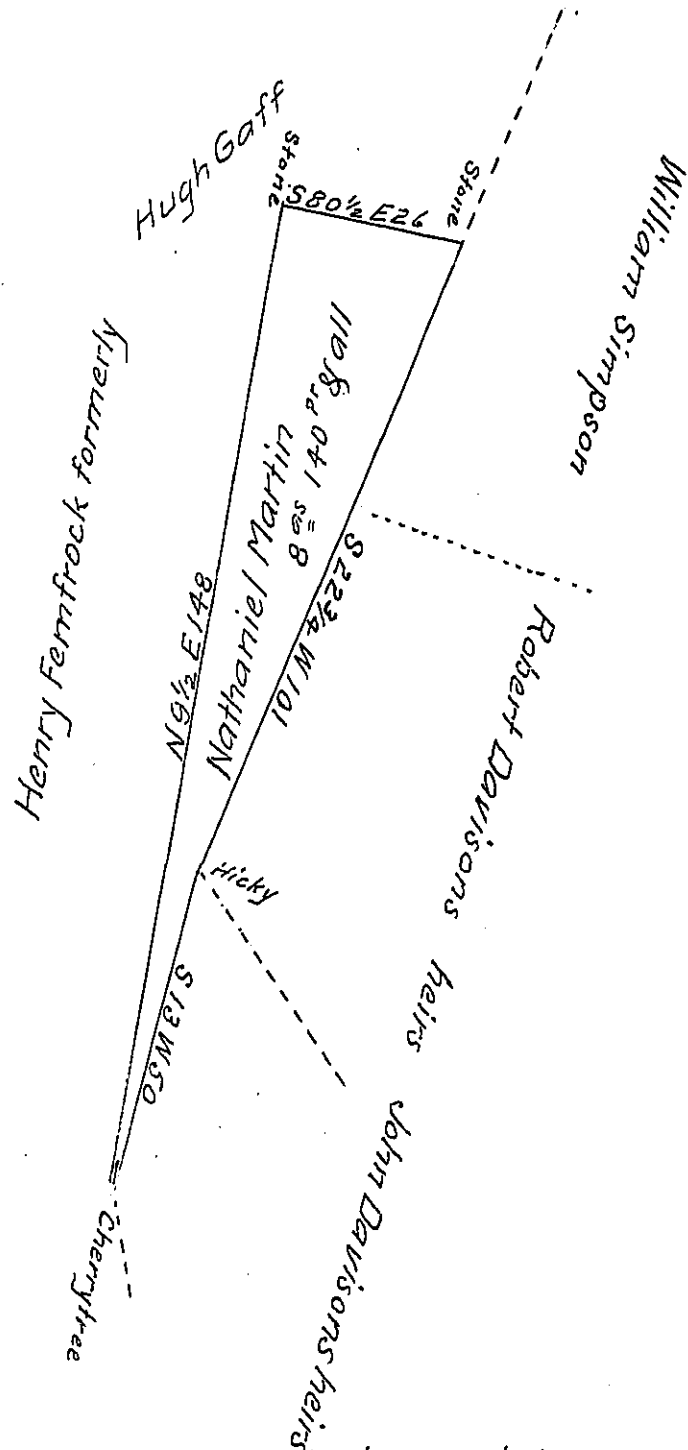


FORM NO. 1.



A Draught of a Peice of Land Situate in Antrim Township Franklin County Containing Eight acres and one hundred and forty perches and the usual Allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Surveyed April 7th 1813 in pursuance of a Warrant granted Nathaniel Martin Dated January 6th 1813

To Andrew Porter Esq^r Thomas Poe D.S.
Surveyor General of Penn^a

I do certify that the greater part of the land contained in the above Survey appears to be clear twenty or twenty five years, and a log house and kitchen thereon which appears to ^{be} erected a few months since, and a family residing therein, Also part of a log barn which appears to have been erected fifteen or twenty years, Given from under my hand this 7th day of April 1813
