

fourth day of November 1839 by virtue of an order of resurvey  
dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1837 granted to Edward Day for 5 acres  
dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of December 1829 containing Seventy six acres  
one hundred and thirty two perches with allowance of six per  
cent for roads &c Resurveyed agreeable to the lines marked  
on the ground on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January 1830 by John A. Gamble
