



Survey'd the above discribed Island on the third day of October 1816. in obedience to an order of appraisment granted to Frederick Hymeman; - Contain ing Five acres and eighty six perches strict measure; - Situate about fifteen perches from the North Bank of river Susquehanna in Lycoming County the farm of James Hepburn in Loysock Township on the North side and Michael Ross in Washington Township on the south side (known by the name of Hepburns Lower Island) - And by virtue of a Warrant granted to Frederick Hymeman on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 1817, Returned the same on the eight day of May 1817 (on the former Survey)
