


FORM NO 1.



Surveyed the above described Island on the third day of October 1816  
in abediance to an order of apraisement granted to Frederick Hyneman  
Containing five acres and one hundred and four perches strict meas-  
ure; Situate in the West Branch of Susquehanna in Lycoming County  
opposite Judge Hepburn's farm on the North & Lands of Michael  
Ross on the south and about about fifteen perches from the North  
side of said river (know by the name of Hepburn's Island) ---  
And by virtue of a Marrant grated to Frederick Hyneman on  
the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 1817, return the same on the eighth day of  
May 1817 (on the former Survey) ---
