



By Virtue of two Warrants one of them dated the 19<sup>th</sup> October 1739 granted to Daniel Zacharias the other granted to to David Beasy dated the 4 September 1747 Surveyed the 17 Octoe 1786 the above two described tracts of land Situate in Whitehall Township formerly in Bucks now in Northampton County Containing in both tracts One hundred and twenty two Acres One hundred and twenty perches & the Allow. of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent &c<sup>o</sup> 3-2 80. 6
