



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Marlborough Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania. Being part of a Tract of 1039 1/2 per etc. That was formerly Surveyed to George Peter Heath, by Warrant of the 31st May Anno. 1738. The above Part Thereof Doth now belong to Henry Bachman. Beginning at a stone in the Line of Fredrick Miller's Land Thence by The Same South West 62 perches to a Stone a Corner of Conrad Zimmermans Land. Thence by the same and by Land of George Brey. North 55^{deg} 25 minuts West 88 1/2 perches to a stone in the Line of the Said George Breys other Land. Thence by the Same North East. 78 perches to a Stone, and by the same and by other Land of the said Henry Bachman. South East. 87 perches to the Place of Beginning. Containing Thirty five Acres and 145 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance for Roads. Resurveyed for the said Henry Bachman on the 8th June Anno 1774.
