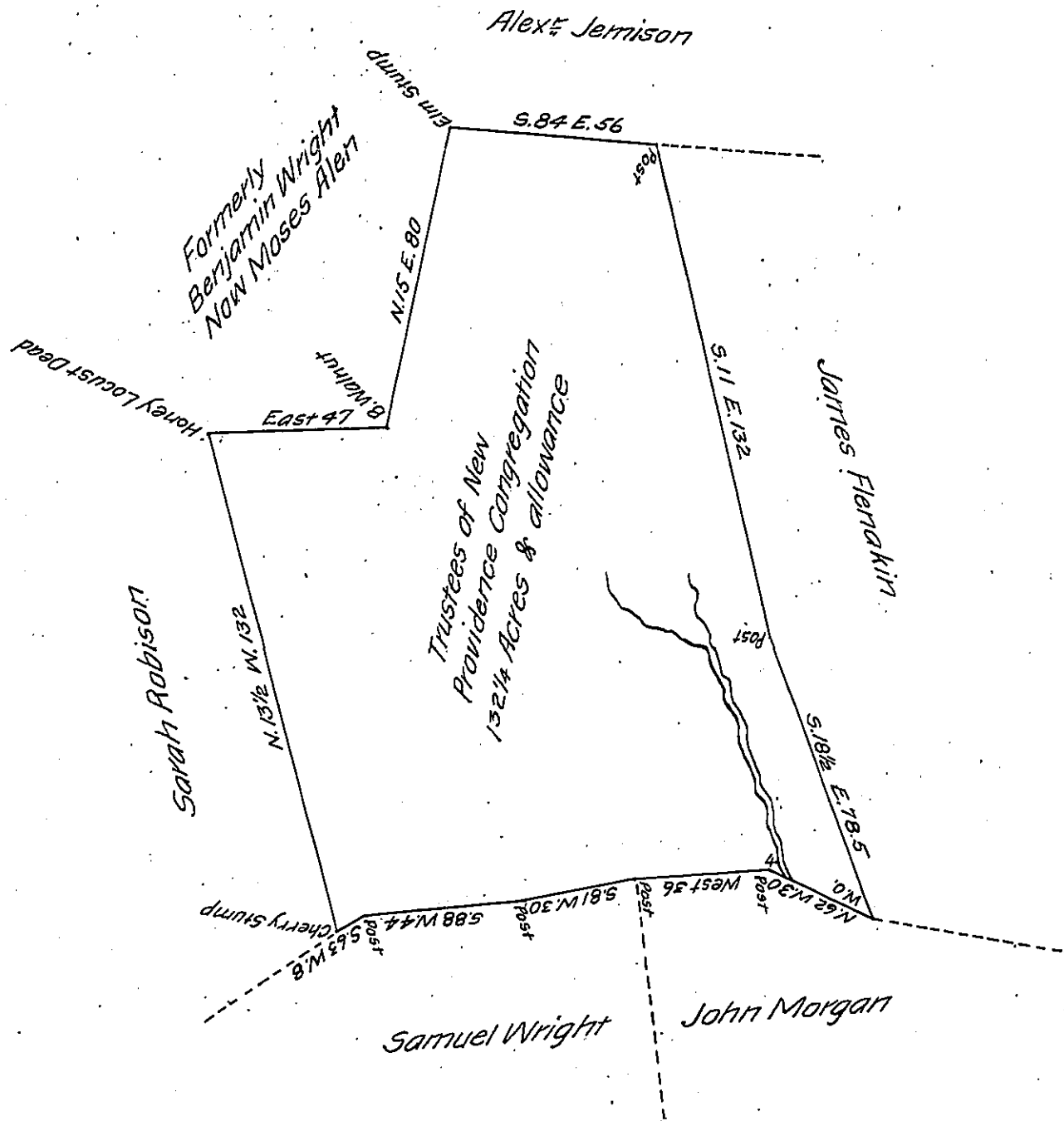


FORM NO 1.



The above is a Draught of a survey made September 15th day 1815 containing 132 Acres and 40 perches of land and allowance of six per cent for Roads, &c. in pursuance of a warrant granted the Trustees of New-providence congregation. Situate in Cumberland Township, Greene County, on the waters of Little Whiteley Creek "Warrant bearing date the 22nd of July. 1815." "Called Hails Gift."
